

Quiz to win 60€ in FNAC cards

Eligibility to participate:

- Form a team of 3 persons, to register on the website
- Be a PhD working in quantum technologies

Rules:

Term definitions

The term “team”, in the following, refers to exactly 3 persons who participate in the quiz in order to win the prize. Each team will have to be registered before the start of the event on the soget.eu website. A team cannot change its members during the event, and if the participants in the team are not present at the beginning of the event, then the team is automatically disqualified. Each participant in the team must be eligible to participate in the quiz, that is to say, they must be pursuing a PhD degree in the field of quantum technologies at the time of the event. If some members are not eligible they may still participate but they should be accepted explicitly by the announcer

The term “announcer”, in the following, refers to one person animating the sessions, which will ask the questions and give points to teams. It might be helped by other people, in order to take notes or count the points, but the one helping must not be part of a team eligible for the winning condition. The announcer must not be part of a team either.

The term “round”, in the following, refers to the moment when the announcer starts to ask a question up to when the announcer says that the round is over, or when it is written explicitly in the following that the round ends.

General rules

Each team will compete against the other teams to win the most points after 40 questions asked by an announcer, each question rightfully answered will give one point. After the 40 questions, if there are any equality for the first place in terms of points amongst the team, an overtime session starts. More questions will be asked until the one of these teams (with the most points) break the equality. The other teams (not with the most points) won't be allowed to participate during this overtime session.

Questions

The questions for the quiz will be written in advance, and the participants won't be allowed to see them. The answers to the questions, to which will refer the announcer to give points, are going to be checked upon many trusted sources beforehand.

The questions will be on various topics, and not restricted to quantum technologies.

Teams

The teams must be eligible as indicated in the terms' definition. Each team is forbidden to use any external help besides the three members to get the answer to a question. In particular, external help from friends, from internet, or any other source that wouldn't be the product of the members of the team. Should it be discovered that a team uses external help, then the team may be disqualified by the announcer. The announcer has also the right not to disqualify a team if the external help doesn't bring a significant advantage in regard to the other teams, such as a dictionary.

Answering procedure and ability to earn points

Each team can only give one answer per question asked by the announcer, and only when the announcer allows them to. When a team wants to answer the question asked by the announcer, they need to use the buzzer. The buzzers will serve as an indication for the announcer in order to choose which team can give its answer, and the announcer will pick the team which used the buzzer the earliest in the round and as soon as possible, even if it is during the question. Any answer given by a team not selected by the announcer explicitly won't be eligible to earn points. When a team has been selected by the announcer, indicated orally, they have 3 seconds to give one answer, if the answer is correct they earn one point and the round ends. If the answer is incorrect, or no answer is given in the 3 seconds, the team won't be able to participate again until the end of the round.

If no team gives the correct answer, the round ends. If no team that is allowed to participate in the round has used their buzzers for at least a minute, the announcer can decide to end the round.

The announcer has the right to clarify any lack of understanding in the above rules, and the clarification given will count as the current rules.

Winning and ending of the game

At the end of the game, the team with the most point is designated winner and instantly wins 3 prepaid cards of 20€ each for the FNAC shop.
